Genesis 3:1-6 Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?'" [2] And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; [3] but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.' " [4] Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. [5] For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." [6] So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

And the rest is history!

Eve's desire was to be more like God. The serpent told her that if she ate the fruit, she would be "like God, knowing good and evil." Was her desire wrong? No. Many Christians today want to be more like God. So why was the punishment so severe for Eve's desire? Eve was wrong in thinking that she could become like God through disobedience. Eve's problem was not her desire. Her problem was that she thought she could achieve her desire with unbiblical methods.

I have never met a Christian who did not want to be more like Jesus. However, I know scores of Christians who confuse God's desires with their own. And when their desires are not met they will use any means at their disposal to make sure that they get what they want. Let's be clear on this: first, it is impossible to please God through disobedience! Second, It doesn't matter what you want. What matters is what God wants!

When things are not going your way, before you act, you need to ask yourself the following three questions. "God, is my heart right with you?" "God, are my desires Your desires?" "God, if You were in my situation, how would You respond?"

It all comes down to the attitude of the heart. Eve attempted to do the right thing the wrong way and the result was disaster! Regardless of what is happening around you, make sure your heart is pure before the Lord and make sure your actions are pleasing to the Lord. Let Him take care of the rest. I have discovered that He is more than willing and He is more than able!
