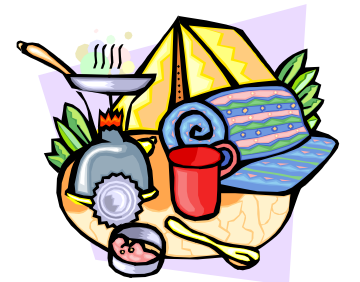

GETTING PRIORITIES IN ORDER

Philippians 1:27

“Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel.”

Every day our lives are filled with decisions. Most decisions are quite mundane such as “do I take the Interstate to work, or do I take a back road?” However, others are much more significant such as “Where do I want to live?: Whom shall I marry?: or What career path will I take?” Then there are life and death decisions such as “Will I have the surgery?: or Do I want to exist on life support?: Finally, there are the eternal questions such as “Am I saved?: Do I want to be saved?: Do I even care if I am saved?”

Regardless of whether or not your decisions are mundane, significant, life and death, or eternal; all decisions must be made with the goal of honoring Jesus. When Paul penned Philippians 1:27, he was writing to a church. He wanted to make sure that every member had the right perspective—an eternal perspective.

God demands that all of our decisions, our actions, our attitudes, our passions and our very lives are to be worthy of the salvation he so graciously bestowed. Why? Because, actions speak louder than words. If our actions do not reflect the fact that we belong to Jesus, then our words will never have any impact. Our priority must be God’s kingdom.
